

Cable laying methods in cable tray trenches

Expansion joints and earth bonding jumpers should be provided where required.

Cable Laying in Trays Cables should be laid in an organized manner, avoiding excessive bending or twisting. Key considerations include:

- Spacing and fill:** Cable fill should not exceed 40% of tray capacity to prevent overheating.
- Fixing intervals:** Cables must be secured at regular intervals to maintain alignment and prevent sagging.
- Identification:** Markers should be installed at joints, bends, crossings, and entry points for easy maintenance.
- Material selection:** Choose cable and tray materials suitable for environmental conditions to ensure durability.
