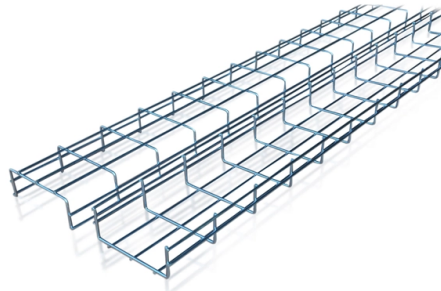

For steel ladder or perforated trays, the tray is typically cut at the bend point, then bent to the desired angle, and bolted together. Care must be taken to maintain a smooth curve to prevent cable damage and ensure proper cable support.

Radius Considerations

While the NEC does not specify a minimum radius for cable tray bends, manufacturers often provide recommended bend radii to prevent cable stress. Common radii for field-fabricated bends range from 12" to 48", depending on tray width and type. Maintaining a proper radius is critical for cable integrity, ease of pulling, and compliance with standards.

Installation Tips

Support: Ensure the reverse bend is adequately supported using wall brackets, ceiling hangers, or center suspensions to prevent sagging.

Alignment: Align the tray sections carefully to avoid twisting or misalignment, which can complicate cable pulling.
