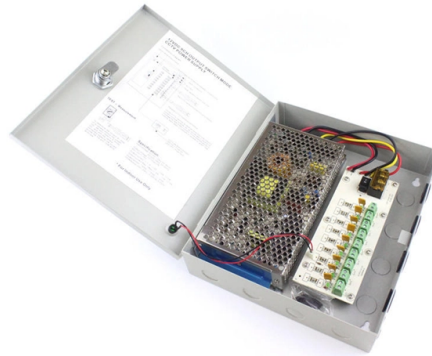


Cable tray vertical connection

A vertical cable tray connection allows secure routing of cables between floors or levels, using risers, elbows, and proper support to maintain safety, organization, and load management.

Overview of Vertical Cable Trays Vertical cable trays, also called riser trays, are specialized systems designed to carry electrical and data cables in a vertical direction, such as between floors or along walls. They provide a structured pathway that prevents cable damage, supports heavy loads, and ensures organized routing. Common types include:

- Ladder-style vertical trays:** Two side rails with cross-bars (rungs) for excellent ventilation and high load capacity, ideal for heavy power cables.

Connection Methods Vertical connections typically involve linking a horizontal tray to a vertical riser using elbows, tees, or custom fittings:

- Elbows:** Used to change the direction of the tray from horizontal to vertical. A horizontal run bends downward to meet the vertical riser, allowing cables to sweep smoothly onto the vertical tray.
- Tees:** In multi-level shafts, a vertical "T" can branch off to horizontal trays on each floor. In practice, this may require custom fittings or software modeling adjustments, as standard software may not automatically generate vertical tees.
- Custom fittings:** For complex layouts, manufacturers often provide BIM content or custom Revit families to model vertical connections accurately.

Support and Installation Proper support is critical to maintain structural integrity and prevent sagging:

- Wall-mounted brackets or cantilever supports:** Secure vertical trays along walls or shafts.
- Trapeze hangers:** Suspended from ceilings for vertical or inclined runs.
- Hanger spacing:** Maximum support spacing depends on tray type and load; for ladder trays, typical spacing is 3–3.6 meters, with load limits per hanger around 318–340 kg.
