Horizontally arranged cable trays should be installed with proper spacing, support, and orientation to ensure safety, minimize interference, and allow easy maintenance. Orientation and Placement Horizontal cable trays can be positioned with the bottom facing a wall or ceiling, and in some cases, small channel trays may be installed upside down for space optimization or aesthetic reasons. The orientation should allow easy access for cable installation, inspection, and maintenance while avoiding obstructions such as pipes, structural columns, or ventilation ducts.

Separation and Segregation To reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI), power cables are typically placed above instrumentation or control cables. Maintaining a minimum vertical and horizontal spacing—commonly at least 300 mm (12 inches)—is recommended. Where space is limited, metal partitions can be used to separate high-current and low-current cables. Segregation also ensures compliance with electromagnetic compatibility (EMC) standards and protects sensitive equipment.

Support and Material Considerations Horizontal trays must be adequately supported along their length to prevent sagging and maintain cable integrity. Rung spacing of 150–230 mm (6–9 inches) is preferred for instrumentation and control cables. Materials should be selected based on environmental conditions: stainless steel or coated aluminum is recommended for corrosion resistance, while ventilated or solid-bottom trays can be chosen depending on heat generation and aesthetic requirements.

Routing and Heat Management Cable trays should follow the shortest practical route with minimal bends to reduce cable length, power loss, and installation complexity. Adequate air gaps between trays are necessary for heat dissipation, especially for high-voltage power cables. In hazardous or high-temperature environments, fire-retardant trays or coatings may be required.
