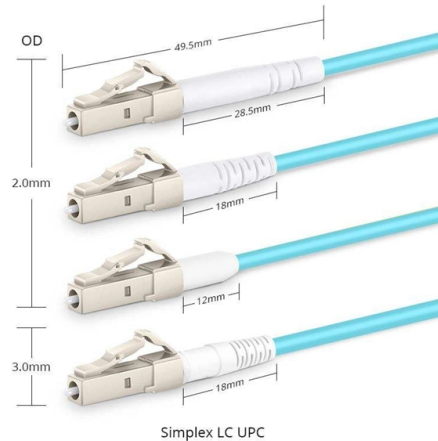


Can network cabinets be operated without power
