

Connecting a home router to fiber optic cable

Step 4: Configure Your Router

Access the router's settings via a web browser using the IP address on the router label. Follow the setup wizard to configure your Wi-Fi network. Change the default username and password to secure your network.

Step 5: Test the Connection

Ensure all cables are securely connected and verify the correct ports are used. Run a speed test to confirm your fiber connection is performing as expected. For the most accurate results, you can connect a computer directly to the ONT.

Tips and Considerations

- Place the ONT close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss.
- Handle fiber connectors carefully; improper seating can reduce signal quality by over 30%.
