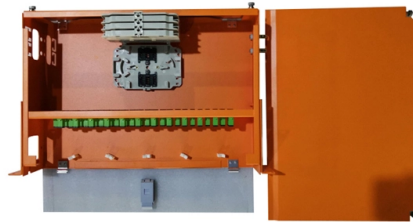


Connecting fiber optic cables in a trench
