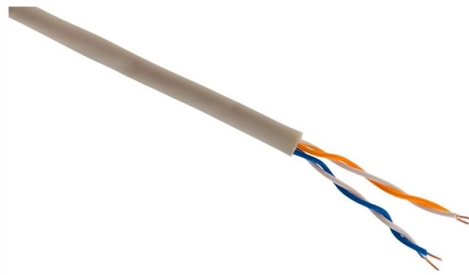


Curvature of optical cable when bent
