- 1. Fusion Splicers** Fusion splicers align and permanently join two fiber ends using an electric arc, creating a continuous glass path with minimal signal loss. Core alignment splicers are used for high-precision single-mode fibers, while cladding alignment splicers are suitable for multimode fibers.
- 2. Fiber Cleavers and Strippers** Fiber cleavers produce a flat, smooth end face on the fiber, essential for low-loss splicing. Strippers remove protective coatings without damaging the fiber, preparing it for termination or splicing.
- 3. Testing Instruments**
 - Optical Power Meters and Light Sources:** Measure signal strength and insertion loss to ensure network performance.
 - Visual Fault Locators (VFLs):** Inject visible light to identify breaks, bends...
