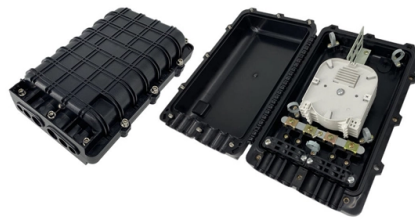


Do 10 Gigabit switches have multi-mode and single-mode optical ports

There are two basic types of optical fiber used for 10 Gigabit Ethernet: single-mode (SMF) and multi-mode (MMF).
