

Does the optical distribution box have to be grounded

Grounding Standards and Practices

National Electrical Code (NEC) Compliance: NEC 770.100 and 770.93 specify that conductive fiber optic components entering or terminating in a building must be grounded or interrupted by an insulating joint. The grounding should occur as close as possible to the point of entry or termination ().

Bonding Conductors: Metallic components are typically bonded to the building's grounding electrode system using a dedicated conductor. While NEC allows a minimum of 14 AWG, manufacturers often recommend a 6 AWG copper conductor for both grounding and bonding purposes ().

Grounding Resistance: The resistance between the grounded components and the main grounding system should be low, generally less than 0.1 ohm, to ensure effective protection ().

Practical Implementation

Indoor Boxes: Wall-mounted or cabinet-style boxes inside buildings should have their metallic parts connected to the telecommunications main grounding busbar (TMGB) or building ground bus ().

Outdoor Boxes: For boxes installed outdoors or in hand-hole wells, grounding is recommended if metallic parts...
