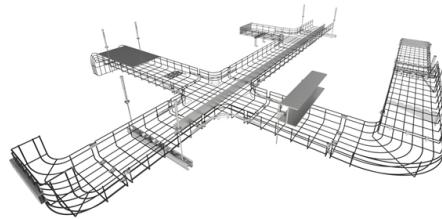


Electronic Component Board Three-Level Distribution Box

Structure and Function

Main Distribution Board (MDB) The main distribution board serves as the primary hub, receiving power from the transformer (typically 0.4kV in residential or commercial setups) and distributing it to secondary boards. It does not supply power directly to end-use devices but includes essential components such as isolating switches, circuit breakers, and Residual Current Devices (RCDs) to ensure overall system safety and centralized control.

Secondary Distribution Boards (SDB) Secondary boards act as intermediate distribution points, often serving specific buildings, floors, or large equipment. They handle three-phase power and connect to motors or heavy loads. These boards emphasize safety with features like dual-door protection, durable coatings, and rainproof designs for outdoor installations. Larger capacity circuit breakers are used to manage higher loads safely.

Tertiary Distribution Boards (TDB) Tertiary boards are located closest to the end-use equipment, supplying 220V single-phase power for individual devices. They follow strict safety standards, often implementing a "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box" principle. This ensures independent protection for each device and may include fixed or portable boxes. A "two-layer protection" strategy is commonly applied, with RCDs at both the tertiary and secondary levels.
