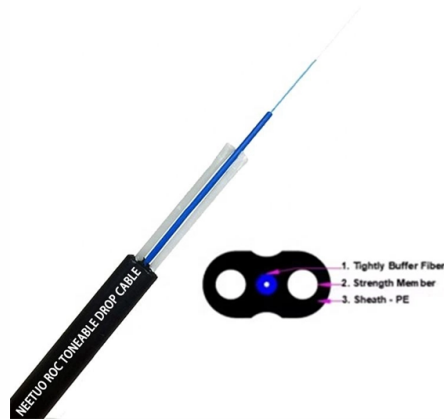


FTTR fiber optic connection to router

- ONT/ONU at Home Entrance:** Converts optical signals into Ethernet or Wi-Fi signals and can branch fiber deeper into the home.
- In-room Fiber Cabling:** Ultra-thin, bend-insensitive fiber cables routed along walls or ceilings to each room.
- In-room Access Points:** Provide Wi-Fi coverage using the fiber backbone, supporting seamless roaming and high-speed connections.

Step-by-Step Connection to a Router

Connect Fiber to ONT/ONU: The fiber drop cable from the building's distribution point connects to the ONT/ONU's optical port. Handle the fiber connector carefully, removing dust caps and aligning the key or tab until it clicks securely.

Ethernet Link to Router: After the ONT/ONU converts the optical signal, use a standard Ethernet cable to connect the ONT/ONU's LAN or Ethernet output port to the WAN/Internet port on your router. This allows your router to distribute the internet to devices via Wi-Fi or wired connections.

Power and Placement: Both the ONT/ONU and router require continuous power. Place them near electrical outlets in dry, ventilated areas, ideally with surge protection. Start by powering the ONT/ONU first to establish a connection with the provider's network, then power on the router.

Verify Connection: Check the ONT/ONU status lights. A solid green power light indicates proper operation. The router should detect the WAN connection and provide internet...
