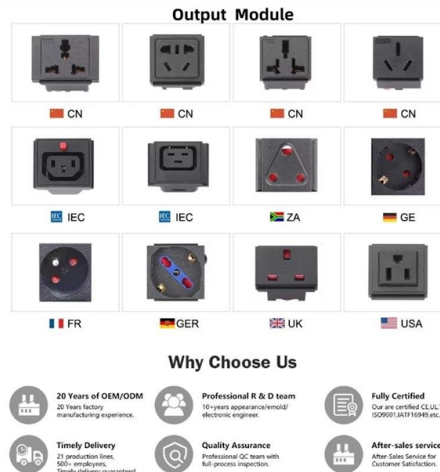


Fiber optic patch cords single-mode multi-mode

Core Differences

Single-mode fiber supports kilometer-level distances, often 40–100 km at 10–100 GbE without repeaters, and is compatible with long-range LR/ER/OS2 transceivers. Multimode fiber is optimized for short-range links, typically up to 300 meters for OM3/OM4 cables at 10–40 GbE, and pairs with lower-cost SR optics.

Applications

Single-mode fiber patch cords: Telecom backbones, metro networks, FTTH deployments, industrial environments requiring long-distance connectivity.

Multimode fiber patch cords: Data centers, intra-building connections, LAN backbones, and high-speed short-range links where cost efficiency is important.
