Verify SFP Compatibility: Ensure the SFP module is supported by the switch model and matches the fiber type (single-mode or multimode). Replace third-party modules with certified ones if necessary.

Inspect and Clean Fiber Connections: Use lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol to clean connectors. Check for visible damage or sharp bends in the fiber cable.

Check Port Configuration: Use commands like `show interface status` to confirm the port is not administratively down. Apply `shutdown` and `no shutdown` to reset the port.

Swap Components: Test the port with a known-good SFP module and fiber cable. If the port works with these, the original module or cable may be faulty.

Test Optical Signal: Use a power meter or OTDR to measure signal strength. Values outside the expected range (typically -15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate signal loss.
