- Smart Fibers with Integrated Sensing:** Distributed Acoustic Sensing (DAS) and Distributed Temperature Sensing (DTS) enable real-time monitoring of infrastructure, enhancing resilience against floods, landslides, and urban traffic management.
- Bend-Insensitive Fibers:** Compliant with ITU-T G.657, these fibers maintain performance in tight or twisted configurations, facilitating rural connectivity and FTTH deployment in challenging terrains.

Deployment Techniques

Modern fiber installations in Sri Lanka use Horizontal Direction Drilling (HDD) and cable jetting, minimizing environmental impact while efficiently laying underground ducts and cables. Networks are tested using Optical Time Domain Reflectometers (OTDRs) to ensure reliability and fault detection.
