Ventilation and Fire Prevention Distribution boxes must allow ventilation and heat dissipation, with openings that automatically close in the event of a fire (). Windows and access points should be waterproof and animal-proof to prevent external hazards (). Electrical Safety Measures All wiring must use insulated cables with secure connections, and incoming/outgoing lines should have protective bends to avoid mechanical stress (). Leakage protectors and automatic switches should be installed according to rated values and arranged for grading and subsection protection ().
