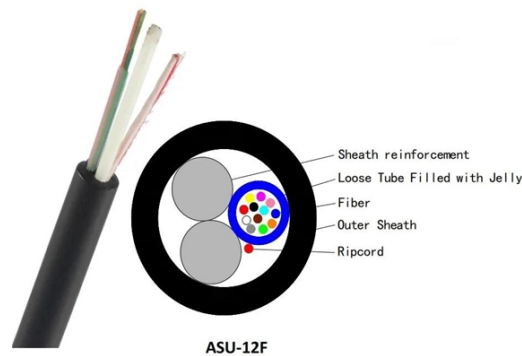

Material and Environmental Considerations Long-span cable trays are typically made from galvanized steel, stainless steel, or pre-galvanized steel, depending on environmental conditions. Galvanization provides corrosion resistance, forming a protective zinc layer that slows oxidation and protects the steel substrate. Stainless steel variants, often AISI 316L, are used in corrosive or high-moisture environments, offering enhanced durability and longevity.

Installation and Maintenance Proper installation is critical to ensure safety and performance. Cable trays should maintain minimum bend radii for cables, and rungs or side rails can be used to secure cables and maintain spacing. Regular inspection is recommended to prevent issues such as short circuits caused by cable damage or environmental exposure. The trays can be ventilated or solid-bottomed, depending...
