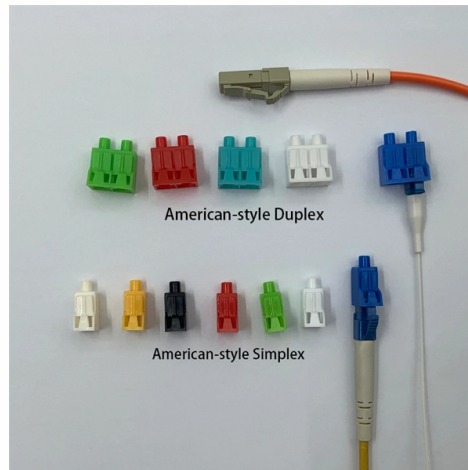

 MCBs should match conductor size, load type, and installation method, while RCBOs provide selective protection for critical circuits. Ensure adequate spacing between SPDs and sensitive equipment to maintain surge protection efficiency.
- 4. Protection and Safety Considerations** Select protective devices based on fault risk, including short circuits, overcurrent, and arc faults. Use SPDs at the main switchboard (Type 2) and near se...
