

How many fiber optic cables are needed for two fiber optic patch panels

So for two connections you would need a total of four fibers. Fiber optic patch cords are fiber cables terminated with connectors on both ends, used to establish optical connections between devices or between devices and patch panels. I have two switches with 1Gb SFP LC Duplex connecting to a patch panel with two LC-SC Simplex patch cords each (I wasn't able to find Duplex patch cords in time), and the same at the other side (two switches connected to another patch panel). The total number of cores for a 1pc fiber patch cable is calculated as the number of branches multiplied by the number of cores per branch (if there are no branches, the number of branches = 1).
