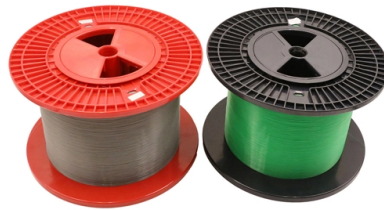


How to connect a box-type fiber optic splitter

Step 4: Connect or Splice Fibers

- Using pigtail:** Splice the pigtail fibers from the splitter to the distribution fibers in the termination box. Use a fusion splicer or mechanical splice kit for a secure connection.
- Using patch cables:** If pre-connectorized, plug the fiber patch cables from the splitter output into the adapter ports of the termination box. Ensure connectors match (SC, LC, or APC) and are fully seated.

Step 5: Route and Secure Fibers Organize fibers in the box using splice trays or routing guides. Avoid sharp bends and maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer. Label each fiber and port clearly to simplify future maintenance.
