

How to connect an electronic fiber optic router

- Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the WAN port on your router.
- Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection. The WAN light should turn solid or blink according to your router's manual.

Step 4: Configure Your Router

- Access the router's configuration interface via a web browser (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) or the manufacturer's app.
- Set up your Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password.
- Enable Quality of Service (QoS) if you use VoIP, gaming, or video conferencing to prioritize traffic.
- Update firmware to ensure security and optimal performance.

Step 5: Optimize Placement and Performance

- Place the router in a central, open location to maximize Wi-Fi coverage.
- Keep both ONT and router near power outlets and in a dry, ventilated area.
- Use wired connections for devices requiring high bandwidth.
