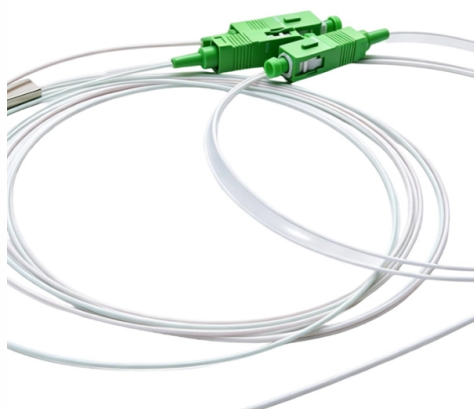


How to connect network cables in a home server rack

- Separate Power and Data Cables:** Keep power cords and network cables apart to reduce electromagnetic interference and maintain signal integrity.
- Labeling:** Clearly label both ends of each cable to simplify troubleshooting and future modifications.
- Patch Panels:** Use patch panels to centralize network connections. This allows short, organized runs from switches to the panel, reducing clutter and making changes easier.

Routing Best Practices

- Front-to-Back Airflow:** Route cables to avoid blocking airflow from front to back, which is critical for cooling servers and networking equipment.
- Horizontal and Vertical Management:** Use horizontal cable managers for short runs and vertical managers for longer, multi-level routing. This keeps cables aligned with rack units and prevents sagging.
- Plan for Expansion:** Leave extra slack...
