

How to connect your home router to fiber optic cable

Precautions

- Always turn off the router before connecting cables to prevent damage.
- Avoid bending the fiber cable sharply, as it can break the delicate glass strands.
- Keep fiber connectors clean and free from dust; use protective caps when not connected.
- If your router lacks a fiber port, a media converter may be required to bridge the fiber to Ethernet.
