

How to install hooks on a distribution box

Height and alignment: Position hooks so cables exit the distribution box cleanly and follow a logical path, avoiding sharp bends or pinch points.

Accessibility: Leave enough space for maintenance and future cable additions.

Step 4: Install Hooks Mark the mounting points on the structural member. Drill or prepare holes as required for the anchor type (through-bolts, chemical anchors, or toggle anchors depending on substrate). Secure the hooks firmly, following manufacturer torque specifications to avoid deformation. Ensure hooks are level and aligned to maintain a neat cable pathway.

Step 5: Route and Secure Cables Lay cables in the hooks without compressing or wrapping them around the hook. Maintain proper bend radius to prevent damage. Avoid overloading hooks beyond their rated capacity. Use additional hooks for long runs or heavy bundles to distribute weight evenly.
