Physical Dimensions The size of the distribution box is determined by the number and type of circuits it will house. For household boxes handling lighting or small power loads, the width is calculated by summing the widths of the switches plus additional clearance (typically 20 mm on each side), the height is the switch height plus 40 mm, and the depth is the maximum switch depth plus 10 mm. Larger boxes for power distribution must also account for the bending radius of incoming wires and space for terminal connections.

Wiring and Installation Specifications Wiring specifications include using high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current. Proper labeling, secure connections, and sealed cable inlets are essential to prevent exposure and ensure safety. The distribution box should be installed in a dry, ventilated location, typically 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground, and firmly fixed to avoid movement.
