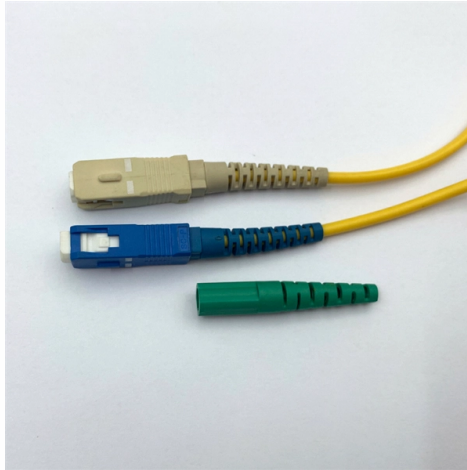


How to lay fiber optic cables without them coiling
