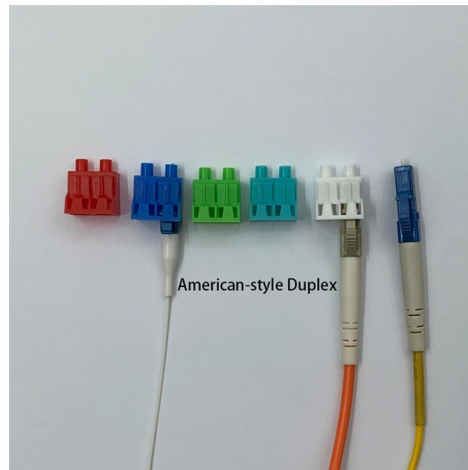

The neutral busbar in the subpanel should not be bonded to the ground, preventing neutral currents from flowing on metal parts and reducing shock hazards. If the subpanel is in a separate building, an additional ground rod is required. Grounding Electrode Considerations Use copper-bonded steel rods or other NEC-approved electrodes for durability and low resistance. Test the grounding system to ensure resistance is below 25 ohms; if not, install multiple rods connected with a continuous conductor. All metal parts of the distribution box, including the enclosure, should be bonded to the grounding system to maintain continuity and safety.
