

How to replace fiber optic cable

Leave extra slack for future maintenance or expansion.

Terminate the cable using fusion splicing or mechanical splicing, ensuring connectors are clean and free from contamination. Protect connectors from scratches and dust.

Testing and Verification After installation, test the fiber using an Optical Time-Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to check for breaks, bends, or splices causing signal loss. Measure attenuation with an Optical Loss Test...
