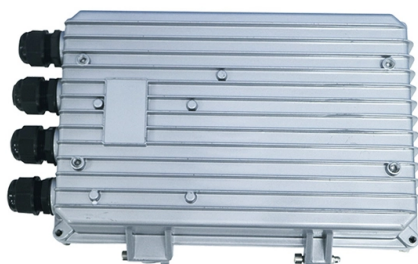


How to swap two fiber optic cables on a router

Two fiber optic cables cannot always be used interchangeably with a router; compatibility depends on connectors, intermediary devices, and router ports.

Key Considerations

Connector Type: Fiber optic cables come with different connectors such as LC, SC, and ST. Routers or ONTs must have compatible ports for the specific connector type; mismatched connectors cannot be directly swapped without adapters or conversion modules.

Router Ports: Most standard home routers have Ethernet (RJ45) ports, which cannot accept fiber optic cables directly because fiber transmits light signals, while Ethernet uses electrical signals. Only routers with SFP or fiber-ready WAN ports can directly interface with fiber cables.

Optical Network Terminal (ONT): In typical fiber setups, the fiber cable connects to an ONT, which converts the optical signal into an Ethernet signal. The router then connects to the ONT via Ethernet. This means that while any router with an Ethernet port can work with fiber internet, the fiber cable itself is not interchangeable with the router without the ONT.

Cable Type and Quality: Even if connectors match, fiber cables differ in single-mode vs. multi-mode and core diameter, which affects signal transmission. Using the wrong type can degrade performance or prevent connectivity.

Practical Implications You cannot plug a fiber cable directly into a standard router unless it has a dedicated fiber port. Two fiber cables are not automatically interchangeable; you must ensure the connector type, mode (single or multi), and the presence of an ONT or SFP port are compatible. For most home setups, the fiber cable goes to the ONT, and the router connects via Ethernet, making the router largely agnostic to the specific fiber cable used, as long as the ONT handles the conversion.
