Mounting must be firm and stable using suitable brackets, screws, or anchors, considering vibration and load. For heavy boxes, floor pedestals or skid mounts may be preferable, while wall or pole mounts are suitable for lighter or outdoor applications. Wiring and Internal Layout Turn off power before wiring. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching load requirements. Maintain neat, logical wiring with clear labeling and proper insulation. Install cable entry points with strain relief and smooth, burr-free holes; use insulating bushings for metal panels. Mount heavier components lower to improve stability and reduce stress on fasteners. Include DIN rails for modular device installation and future upgrades. Grounding and Safety Protection Ground the metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and all metallic components inside. Connect protective neutral wires reliably through terminal boards. Equip each circuit with breakers, fuses, or surge protectors to prevent over...
