NEC also requires a clear working space in front of the panel, typically 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high, to maintain safe access.

- Accessibility:** The height should allow easy reading of labels and operation of breakers without strain.
- Moisture Protection:** Avoid installing near sinks, uncovered outdoor areas, or locations prone to flooding.
- Safety:** Place the box away from potential impacts or hazards, and ensure it is firmly mounted on a stable surface.
- Maintenance Convenience:** The height should facilitate inspection, replacement, and repairs without requiring ladders or tools.

Summary For most residential and light commercial installations, mount the distribution box at 1.4-1.7 meters for indoor use, at least 3 feet above ground for outdoor use, and ensure the top breaker does not exceed 2 meters from the floor to comply with NEC...
