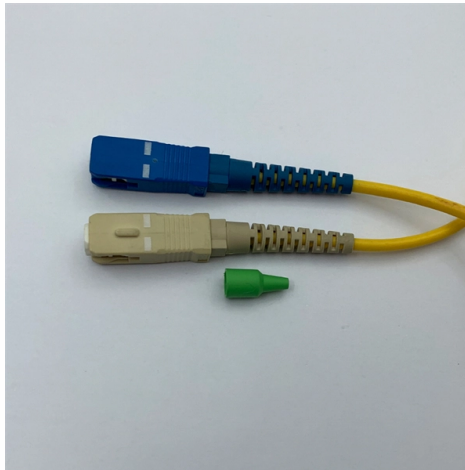


Making Armored Optical Cable Connectors

Understanding Armored Optical Cable Armored optical cables have a metal armor layer (stainless steel or corrugated steel) between the outer sheath and the fiber core, providing protection against crushing, moisture, rodents, and mechanical stress.
