Network modules inside a server rack are connected using structured cabling through patch panels, switches, and fabric extenders, with careful attention to port types, redundancy, and cable management. Core Connection Methods

- 1. Direct Server-to-Fabric Connections:** In blade server environments like Cisco UCS, each server connects to an I/O module (IOM) via backplane ports called Host Interfaces (HIFs). The IOM then connects externally to fabric interconnects using Network Interfaces (NIFs) with SFP+ or QSFP+ cables, supporting speeds from 10 to 40 Gbps depending on the module type. Typically, fabric extenders are configured in pairs for redundancy, providing high aggregate throughput to the chassis (e.g., 160–320 Gbps) and ensuring low-latency, lossless connectivity for Ethernet and Fibre Channel over Ethernet (FCoE) traffic.
- 2. Patch Panel Connections:** For copper Ethernet networks, RJ45 patch panels serve as centralized connection points. The rear side of the panel terminates cables from servers or workstations using IDC punch-downs, while the front side connects to switches via short patch cables. Rack-mounted patch panels are usually 19-inch wide and 1RU in height, and proper termination follows T568A or T568B wiring standards. Pass-through panels can simplify connections by eliminating the need for punch-downs.
- 3. Rack View and Visual Mapping:** Software tools like Schneider Electric's rack view allow visualization of network connections from servers to switches. Ports are color-coded (green for connected, gray for available), and users can create or verify connections, ensuring correct cable types and port compatibility. Connections between different rooms or racks are typically documented in a table view.
