AI Overview

Cambodia is actively expanding its bridge infrastructure, with major projects including the Phnom Penh Mekong River bridges, the Cambodia-Korea Friendship Bridge, and the country's tallest bridge on National Road 10. Phnom Penh Bridge Expansion Phnom Penh is set to have 10 bridges across the Tonle Sap, Bassac, and Mekong rivers by 2030, aimed at reducing traffic congestion, improving urban connectivity, and supporting economic growth. Currently, the city operates seven major bridges, including the Cambodia-Japan Friendship Bridge (1999), Cambodia-China Friendship Bridge (2015), Prek Pnov (2002), Monivong Bridges (old and new), Russey Keo Suspension Bridge (2012), and Koh Pich-Koh Norea (2020). These new bridges will further enhance mobility, reduce travel times by 30-40% during peak hours, and facilitate logistics for Phnom Penh, which hosts 75% of Cambodia's industrial activity.

Cambodia-Korea Friendship Bridge The Cambodia-Korea Friendship Bridge is a major upcoming project connecting Phnom Penh to Kandal Province via the Night Market and Chroy Changvar. Currently in the detailed design study phase, this bridge is supported by the Korean Ministry of Economy and Finance and financed by the Korea Development Bank, with a total cost of \$235 million. Once completed, it will significantly improve connectivity between Phnom Penh and the Mekong Key Satellite City development zone, enhancing urban integration and regional transpor...
