Norwegian residential power distribution typically uses a 3-phase 230/400 V system with grounded center taps, often supplied without a neutral in older IT systems. Voltage and Phase Configuration In Norway, most homes receive 3-phase power, with standard voltages of 230 V between phases and 400 V line-to-line for newer installations. Older systems may use an IT (isolated) system, where the transformer is floating with respect to ground, sometimes with a local ground connection. In these setups, there is typically no neutral conductor, and standard outlets are connected between two phases, giving 230 V. Modern installations may include a neutral for 230/400 V+N systems, allowing standard single-phase appliances to operate safely. Grounding and Safety Grounding in Norway varies depending on the system type. In IT systems, the transformer is isolated from ground, and earth faults are monitored using residual current devices (RCDs) or ground fault indicators. In newer TN-C-S or TN-S systems, the center tap of the transformer is grounded, providing a reference point for safety and enabling protective devices to operate correctly. This ensures that in case of a fault, overcurrent protection or RCDs can disconnect the circuit to prevent electric shock. Distribution Box Setup A typical Norwegian distribution box (sikringsenskap) contains: Circuit breakers (automatsikringer) for each branch circuit, rated according to the load. Residual current devices (RCDs / jordfeilbryter) to detect earth faults. Busbars for phase connections, sometimes including a neutral bus in modern systems. Main switch to disconnect the entire household from the supply. Branch circuits are usually divided into lighting, general outlets, and high-power appliances (e.g., electric heating, ovens). Each circuit is protected individually, and the distribution box is designed to handle the 400 V three-phase supply, distributing it safely to 230 V outlets and 400 V appliances.
