MTP/MPO (Multi-Fiber Push-On/Pull-off): Used for high-density multi-fiber connections, often in data centers. Applications Data Centers: Connect servers, storage devices, and switches across racks and floors to ensure fast, reliable internal network communication. Telecommunication Networks: Connect optical modules in backbone, metropolitan, and access networks for long-distance transmission of voice, data, and video services.
