- Protection:** Place the splice in a protective tray or sleeve to prevent mechanical stress and environmental damage.
- Testing:** Verify insertion loss and return loss to ensure the assembly meets performance standards.

Special Considerations: Multi-fiber pigtails use color-coded fibers for easy identification, and armored or waterproof pigtails are used in harsh environments.
