Modern distribution boxes often include circuit breakers, RCDs, surge protection, and other modules, so plan for neat cable routing and ergonomic arrangement. Ensure the enclosure is large enough to avoid overcrowding, which can cause overheating or make maintenance difficult. For example, if your calculated requirement is 18 slots, a 24- or 30-slot box may be appropriate.

Installation Considerations

- Location:** Install in a dry, accessible, and well-ventilated area, typically at a height of 1.5–1.8 meters for easy operation and inspection.
- Enclosure type:** Choose based on environment—steel or plastic for indoor use, higher IP/NEMA ratings for outdoor or industrial settings.
- Mounting:** Securely fasten the box to a stable surface to prevent movement or tilting.
- Wiring:** Use copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load, ensure proper insulation, grounding, and clear labeling of circuits.
