- Cable Routing:** Cables should be installed in dedicated shafts or raceways, avoiding ducts used for dust, flammable vapors, or HVAC systems.
- Sequential Connection:** The feeder enters the first panel, connects to the busbar or breaker, and continues to the next panel. Proper labeling and documentation are essential for maintenance and troubleshooting.
