Overview

Use a high-port or uplink-heavy UniFi switch (e., USW-24-POE or USW-48) as the central hub. Use LAG (2+ ports) for speed and redundancy. If you must daisy-chain, keep depth to 2 hops max. Aggregating ports on a UniFi switch allows you to combine multiple physical network connections into a single logical link, increasing bandwidth and providing redundancy. This process, also known as link aggregation or LAG (Link Aggregation Group), is essential for optimizing network performance. LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol): LACP is an industry-standard protocol (802.3ad) that dynamically manages link aggregation, provides automatic failover, and helps prevent misconfigurations by ensuring both ends of the link agree on the aggregation settings.
