

The wiring in the distribution box is not grounded



Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be $< \Omega$. According to NEC Article 250, both the neutral and ground wires must be connected only in the main panel or at the first service disconnect. They should never be connected together downstream of the service equipment, such as in subpanels or other parts of the circuits. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. However, in actual operation, problems such as loose terminals and broken terminals often occur, resulting in poor electrical connection and affecting power transmission.

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
