

What are the four network cables on a network patch panel



Overview

In a typical structured network: Wall jack → in-wall solid-core cable → patch panel → short patch cord → switch. On the rear side, each cable is punched down following T568A or T568B wiring schemes. An Ethernet patch panel is typically a metal frame with rows of RJ45 ports on the front and punch-down or keystone terminations on the rear. Both types are used to make patch cables. Match Your Standards: Always match your patch panel category (Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6a) to your Ethernet cables to prevent network bottlenecks.
