

What to do if fiber optic splices keep breaking



Overview

Start with the simplest, fastest checks (visual inspection, cleaning, cable routing) and only move to instrumentation (power meter, VFL, OTDR) when those steps don't clear the fault. This saves time and prevents needless part swaps. The performance of a fiber optic splice is determined by a number of factors, including the quality of the fiber, the cleanliness of the splice, and the techniques used to make the splice. Whether it's from misalignment, dust contamination, environmental stress, or poor splice protection, these problems can quickly escalate if not.
