

Wiring of 2 circuit breakers in the distribution box

The second box acts as a sub-panel. Its neutral and ground bars should be separate to prevent neutral-ground bonding issues. Connect the feeder's hot wires to the second box's main breaker, neutral to the neutral bar, and ground to the grounding bar.

Step 4: Install Branch Circuit Breakers Slide each branch breaker onto the busbar until it clicks securely. Connect hot wires from each circuit to the breaker terminal, neutral wires to the neutral bar, and ground wires to the grounding bar. Ensure each breaker matches the wire gauge and load (e.g., 15A breaker for 14-gauge wire, 20A for 12-gauge wire).

Step 5: Safety and Testing Verify all connections are tight and properly insulated. Ensure load balancing across phases if using a multi-phase system. Turn on the main breaker and test each branch circuit for correct operation. Follow NEC or IEC codes for spacing, b...
